

Hilhi Youth Basketball Player Code of Conduct

As an HYBA player, you agree to live up to your responsibilities and set a positive example for your teammates and opponents by following this code of conduct:

- 1. Represent Hilhi Youth Basketball with integrity both on and off the court. You are expected to be honest and exhibit proper character at all times.
- 2. Demonstrate respect for your coaches. Follow direction and be ready to work hard, learn and improve your game at all times. Listen to your coach first, do not be distracted by spectators or parents.
- 3. Respect the judgment of the officials, even if you disagree with their calls. Do not argue or complain and refrain from using gestures that indicate dissatisfaction.
- 4. Profanity and/or abusive language will not be tolerated under any circumstances.
- 5. Show good sportsmanship at all times. This includes before, during and after games, regardless of the outcome of the game.
- 6. Respect all practice and game facilities. Clean up after yourself. Do not leave belongings and/or garbage behind.
- 7. Be a responsible teammate. This includes arriving on time to practices and games, wearing proper attire/uniform and being mentally and physically prepared to play at all times.
- 8. Attendance at practice is mandatory and essential for your growth and development as a basketball player and teammate. You must notify your coach in advance if you are going to miss a practice. There will be consequences for missed practices, which will be communicated clearly depending on the offense.
- 9. School work is a priority for all student athletes. Strive for excellence in the classroom, as well as on the court. Ask for help and/or let your coach or parent know if you are having trouble in school.
